WHO WE ARE:

The Region 8 Comprehensive Center (CC) is one of 19 Regional CCs in the CC Network that provides high-quality, intensive capacity-building technical assistance to clients from state, regional, and local educational agencies and schools in Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio. The Region 8 CC is operated by ICF and co-directed by Dr. Caitlin Howley and Dr. Kerry Hoffman.

ICF, a global consulting services company, was selected by the U.S. Department of Education to operate the Region 8 CC between 2019–2024. ICF is the lead organization supported by RMC Research Corporation and Applied Engineering Management (AEM) Corporation as major partners in delivering services through the Region 8 CC.

WHAT WE DO:

The Region 8 CC collaborates with state education agency (SEA) leaders and their regional and local colleagues to build and enhance SEA capacity to strengthen and implement education across the Region 8 CC service area.

HOW WE WORK:

- Each SEA is supported by two state coordinators, who take the lead in:
 - > understanding each state's needs
 - customizing and delivering technical assistance that addresses each state's needs
 - benchmarking progress toward key objectives—with the ultimate goal of improving student outcomes.

Also working with the Region 8 CC state coordinators are technical assistance specialists and subject matter experts who are on call to assist teams serving our states.

All Region 8 CC support services are informed through needs-sensing and the identification of education priorities. Our services are evidence based and include:

- Coaching, co-facilitating in-person advisories, serving as a thought partner, and structuring communities of practice
- Opportunities to learn from experts in their region and colleagues from across the U.S.
- Identifying and communicating opportunities to learn from experts and colleagues in the region and across the U.S.

- · Professional learning, webinars, and conferences.
